

One-year schedule for transfer or second bachelor's students

This represents a possible schedule for a junior transfer or second bachelor's degree pre-journalism student seeking a degree with an emphasis in Public Relations. Some courses listed here fulfill more than one requirement, as indicated. When choosing courses, watch for prerequisites. This schedule suggests heavy concentration in the lower-division core courses in journalism during the first term of study allowing the student to apply for conditional admission at the end of the first term. (Twenty-four UO graded credits are required for full admission. Transfer and second bachelor's degree students who pass the premajor courses with the minimum grades and earn a UO GPA of 2.90 or better [2.70 or better if admitted to pre-journalism status before Fall 2011] will be granted conditional admission so they may start the Gateway to Media series. These students' applications will be considered for full admission after their second term at the university.)
